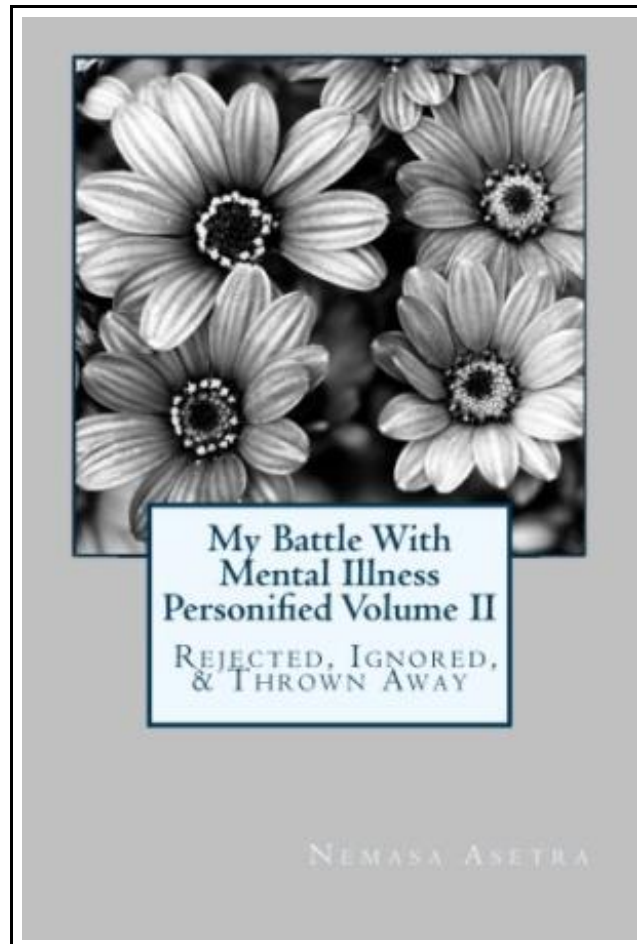

She talks about her adoption into the Hartman family and she ends with a note on the lessons she has learned in life. She also talks about her latest diagnosis with ADHD some activities related to work experience and her latest issues that created controversy with complaints to addressing concerns with elected officials asking for their support in matters of mental illness awareness.
